*“I’m excited to be working with Jayne as a fellow female director, it’s a first for me with two women on the board and I am already enjoying getting stuck in,”* Laure continued.

Since starting with Miniclipper Logistics Laure has received a warm welcome from the team, and despite joining in a third lockdown the transition has been smooth.

Miniclipper Logistics celebrated its half century of trading on 23 March 2021 by announcing a £5.5million investment in its transport and warehousing divisions, as it heads for a record year of trading in 2020/21.
